

Notices Regarding Administrative Staff Members Who Assist in Research Projects

Approved at the Administrative Council Meeting on February 27, 2006

- Article 1. Full-time Professors running a research project in the university or from other institution may request university staff members (including Teaching Assistants) to take part in the project as part-time Project Assistants.
- Article 2. Upon receiving approval for the project, Professors running research projects sponsored by government or private organizations may request university staff members to assist in project administration. The Human Resources Division and University Extension Division must then be notified of the request. If the project is related to government research, the Research and Development Division must also be notified.
- Article 3. University staff members taking positions assisting projects must not take on more than two projects at one time. Compensation received for each project must not exceed 8,000 NTD per month. Staff members who receive special approval will be exempted from this regulation.
- Article 4. Staff members assisting in research projects without prior approval will have their performance assessed for the academic year. Staff members who violate related regulations will not be allowed to take part in future research projects.
